'Women Safety Plan'

- Duty officer should be briefed so that when-ever any information of assault upon or indecent behavior towards women is received at PS, following action is taken immediately:
 - Sending police party to the victim lady without delay.
 - Diarize the matter.
 - Registering the complaint promptly.
 - Arrest of the accused.
 - Seek assistance of Protection Officer, if required.
- PS mobiles should give coverage to school and colleges particularly during opening and closing hours. In Bolpur, Rampurhat, Suri, Sainthia and Nalhati Township, special team should be created and drive should be started to intercept 'Road-Romeos' and take legal action against them. Lady police should be included in the teams. OCs and ICs of these police stations should make a list of tuition centers and
- It has been seen that one of the reasons of spurt in eve-teasing is the growth of liquor-dens, drug addicts, rowdies, roughs and gamblers. OCs and ICs should take pro-active measures to crack down upon illegal liquor dens, 'ganja-theks', rough-rowdies and gamblers.
- Special vigil should be given to picnic spots, parks and open grounds and bus stands. ICs and OCs should seek assistance from local municipalities and civic authorities regarding this.
- Meeting should be conducted with local clubs and they should be sensitized about the women safety.
- All police stations have committee of eminent citizens. Meeting with these committee should be organized and advice might be sought from these.
- Investigation of rape cases should be completed with-in 90 days of arrest of the accused person[s] and all such cases should be monitored so that 'custody trial' can be done. Cls and SDPOs and Zonal Dy SPs would supervise the cases closely.
- FIR should be lodged in case of missing children and women and 'SOP circulated by PD-West Bengal' should be followed strictly.
- A 'Women in Distress Helpline' [8900-750-555] has been opened at district HQ. This should be advertised in all police station at the entrance.
